The King's University BIBL5305 - The Life of Jesus in Historical Context Dr. John Spurling 817-552-3776 Fall Semester 2015

Course Description:

This course focuses on a multifaceted examination of the life and teachings of Jesus. An emphasis will be placed on the significance of references to Jesus through history including the incarnation and humanity of Jesus as a "typical" rabbi of the Second Temple period. Also, this course will trace the significant events in Jesus life and their impact on the fulfillment of prophecy.

Course Purposes:

Upon satisfactory completion of this course participants will be able to:

- A. develop a living portrait of the historical Jesus from the biblical text and other related sources.
- B. explore the various human characteristics of Jesus as a Jewish rabbi from the second temple period.
- C. gain insight into the teaching ministry of Jesus, through a detailed examination of the world of Jesus.
- D. understand the setting of Christ's life with its social, political, and spiritual aspects.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon satisfactory completion of the course participants will have:

- A. Understood the value of Christ's incarnation to humanity and the overall Kingdom of God.
- B. Realize the universal and personal importance of the birth, life, death and resurrection of Christ.
- C. Comprehend how Christ responded to the many different elements of society in which He lived.
- D. Know how to model the Lord Jesus Christ as Lord, God, King, Master and Savior in their life and ministry.

- D. Jesus Teaching Research Project: Complete a biblical review and evidence supporting the rabbinic teaching methodology used by Jesus. Due Date: Oct. 21st.
- E. **Research Paper:** Write a 14-16 page paper on a selected topic from a specific topic option provided by the professor. **Due Date: Nov. 17**th.
- F. Final Exam: An examine covering the second half of course content will be given during finals week.
